



# NetSupport School Digital Journals



All key actions and events during the lesson can be added to a journal file, these can include:


- Details of the lesson objectives.
- A class attendance register.
- Specific notes, resources and screenshots taken or used during the lesson.
- Survey and test details and results.
- Question and Answer module scores.
- Lists of approved websites for research.
- “On the fly” screenshots during a demonstration (teacher or student).
- Details of any homework set.
- Individual student notes can be added whenever they are required.
- Target words / topics used for any comprehension or research assignments.
- Transcripts of any electronic chat conversations.
- Copies of any NetSupport School inbuilt Whiteboard sessions.



The Digital Journal is available at any time for both teacher and students as a PDF document. Each lesson can be automatically added to an existing journal file as a new chapter and the journal can be customised to carry a school or college logo. Students can access their journal from the Student Toolbar; this also provides the input when a student wishes to add personalised notes to their own journal.

When a student is absent from a lesson, they can be sent a copy of the digital journal so they have a full summary of the topics covered. When they return, the teacher can even send missing items from their journal and synchronise it with the teacher's copy.

The Journal is also a valuable tool for teachers, keeping a record of all content used and discussions undertaken. This can be utilised in the following year and applied as a supplement to existing lesson plans. The Journal also provides a single resource for recording the results of student tests and surveys, as well as a class register recording all students who were present. The Journal is a unique feature to NetSupport School.
