

## Installing NetSupport School 10.50 for use with Wyse Streaming Manager (WSM)

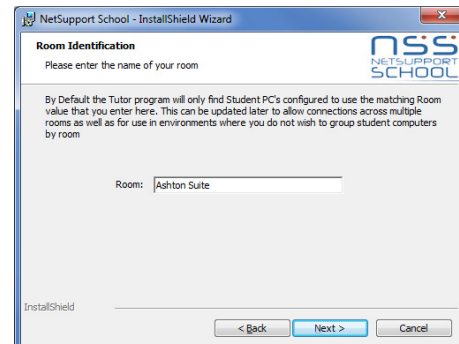
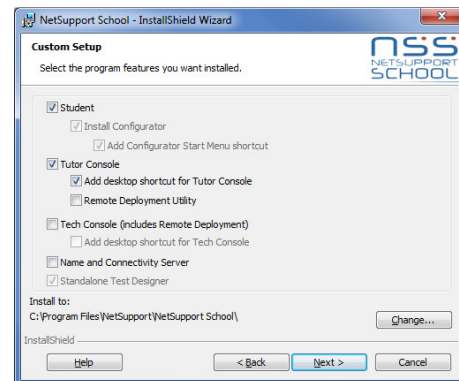
### Planning an Installation

For a Teacher to be able to connect and communicate with each Student the NetSupport School Student component must be installed in the OS Image that will be streamed to the Student Devices. It is recommended that the NetSupport Tutor component is published using the Wyse Publisher and delivered to Teaching staff as a Mandatory Application, however, it is possible to install the NetSupport Tutor into the OS image if required.

### Installing NetSupport School

On the Reference Device used to capture the WSM Zero Client OS image run the NetSupport School installation program and follow the on screen instructions. At the 'Setup Type' dialog select Custom.

1. On the 'Custom Setup' dialog choose the Student option.
2. If you require the NetSupport Tutor to be installed in the OS image you should also select the Tutor Console option. Alternatively, use the Wyse Publisher to create an Application Set for the NetSupport Tutor to be streamed to the Teachers Wyse Zero Client. Please refer to the Wyse Publisher guide for more detailed information.
3. On the Room Identification dialog enter the name of the Room that the virtual desktop sessions are located in, this information will be used to ensure that the Teacher and Students are connected to each other using NetSupport School.
