### Why use a Digital Journal?

A typical lesson can contain a wealth of content: notes, website links, video, audio, screenshots, images – and more. NetSupport School's unique Digital Journal offers a way to create a record of each lesson that is convenient for teachers to refer to and handy for students to use as a revision aid further down the line.

### What can it include?

All key information from a lesson can be added to a journal file:

- Lesson objectives
- Class register
- Notes, resources and screenshots
- Survey/test details and results
- Question and Answer module scores
- Lists of approved websites for research
- "On the fly" screenshots from a demonstration (teacher or student)
- Details of any homework set
- Students can add their own personal notes
- Target words/topics for comprehension or research assignments
- Transcripts of any electronic chat conversations
- Copies of any NetSupport School inbuilt Whiteboard sessions



### Who can access it?

The Digital Journal is available at any time for both teacher and students to access as a PDF document.

Teachers can add a note of all the references and resources from the lesson to create a useful crib sheet of what was covered.

Students can access their version of the journal from the Student Toolbar – and add their own personal notes from here.

### Benefits for students and teachers

If students are absent from school, the digital journal is a helpful summary of the lesson, allowing them to see the topics that were covered and investigate the accompanying resources provided by the teacher (links, images, screenshots etc). They can also use it to refresh their memory on topics when revising.

The journal is also an important tool for teachers to keep a record of all lesson content and student information. It allows them to record who was present – as well as include the results of any student tests and surveys. They can then use it as a supplement to existing lesson plans – or as a reference for the following year.
